## District 3 Candidates Forum

*Featuring Fresno City Council candidates Miguel Arias and Tate Hill*

Fresno CA – September 21, 2018

Chinatown Fresno Foundation is hosting a Candidates Forum for District 3 candidates Miguel Arias and Tate Hill on Tuesday, October 2 from 5:30-6:30 pm. The event will be held at 1048 E Street in Chinatown. Questions will include both scripted and audience questions.

People who care about District 3, especially Chinatown, are welcome. People throughout District 3 have been invited. In addition to Chinatown, District 3 covers the rest of Downtown Fresno, the Cultural Arts District, Southwest Fresno, West Fresno and part of the Tower District.

The venue, located within RMC Enterprises at 1048 E Street, seats up to 100 people. The event will begin with an informal gathering of the audience and the candidates. At 5:10, the Forum will begin. A moderator will offer each candidate three minutes for introduction.

Moderator questions will relate to Chinatown, as well as other areas of District 3, with the candidates having access to the questions ahead of time. The question list will be made available to everyone at the door.

The audience will have ten minutes to ask questions following the prepared questions. The event will close with a two-minute summary by each candidate.

Both candidates have roots in District 3. Arias worked in West Fresno as a farmworker to attend college. He currently serves as the Chief Information Officer for the Fresno Unified School District and is a State Center Community College District Trustee. He lives in Downtown Fresno with his family.

Hill was raised in West Fresno, works in Downtown and lives in the Tower District. He is the Senior Manager of Administration at Access Plus Capital, a subsidiary of Fresno Economic Opportunities Commission.

The League of Women Voters will be registering voters during the event. The last day to register to vote in the November 6 election is October 22.
